

# Robert E. Simon Jr. Music Scholarships

Through The Reston Chorale's Robert E. Simon Jr. Music Scholarships, high school and college vocalists expand their musical horizons by performing in The Reston Chorale, and receive financial awards to support their education. Financial scholarships are awarded in May, based upon the number of concert segments music scholars successfully complete during the season.



## Scholarship Awards

The Reston Chorale awards scholarships each season to:

- **High school students (grades 9-12)** enrolled in public or private school performing arts programs (e.g., chorus, band, orchestra, etc.) Home school students are also eligible.
- **Undergraduate college students** taking at least six credit hours per semester or quarter, regardless of major.

Music scholars are selected by audition, and participate in The Reston Chorale's rehearsals and concerts throughout the season. In addition to awarding scholarship funds (up to \$300 per season for high school students and up to \$500 for college students), The Reston Chorale waives costs for membership dues and music (an annual value of more than \$400) and loans concert attire to scholarship program participants.
